36	Sec. 2. Retroactivity. This Act applies retroactively to persons applying for participation in the elderly low-cost drug
38	program on or after August 1, 1999.' '

42	This amendment replaces the bill. As amended, this bill will increase the number of persons eligible for and the costs of
44	the Elderly Low-cost Drug Program by undetermined amounts. Future requests for General Fund appropriations may be required
