	30	This bill may reduce prosecutions for Class D crimes. If the number of jail sentences is reduced, the savings to the counties are estimated to be \$82.48 per day per prisoner. The
	32	amount of any reduction of jail time and the resulting savings to the county jail system are expected to be insignificant.
	34	The Judicial Department may realize some minor savings from
	36	reductions of workload, administrative costs and indigent defense costs associated with the minimal number of cases that will no
