Sec. 1. 29-A MRSA §1759, sub-§1, as enacted by PL 1993, c. 683, Pt. A, §2 and affected by Pt. B, §5, is amended to read:

1. Issuance. A law enforcement officer, permit-certified police dispatcher or employee of the Bureau of Motor Vehicles designated by the Secretary of State may issue a permit allowing operation of an uninspected vehicle to an inspection station for inspection. For purposes of this subsection, a "permit-certified police dispatcher" means a police dispatcher who is certified by a municipal police department to issue permits pursuant to this subsection.
