SENATE AMENDMENT " A " to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 247, L.D. 351, Bill, "An Act to Include Marine Products on Roadside Signs"

Amend the amendment by striking out all of the 2nd paragraph after the title and inserting in its place the following:

'Further amend the bill in section 3 in paragraph H by striking out all of the last underlined sentence (page 2, lines 17 to 20 in L.D.) and inserting in its place the following: 'A seller may not erect more than 4 signs pursuant to this paragraph. If a seller elects to erect signs pursuant to section 1911, subsection 2, that seller is prohibited from erecting signs under this paragraph.'

SUMMARY

This amendment allows a seller to erect signs advertising products produced or sold on the seller's premises, as in the original bill. This amendment also restricts a seller to erecting signs as proposed in the bill or using official business directional signs, but not both.
