COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 258, L.D. 362

Further amend the bill by inserting at the end before the 2 summary the following:

'FISCAL NOTE

The Department of Transportation will incur some minor 8 additional costs to provide certain written notifications to municipalities. These costs can be absorbed within the 10 department's existing budgeted resources.'

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SUMMARY

This amendment requires the Department of Transportation to explain in writing why it denied a request from a municipality to change a speed limit and requires the department to offer to meet with the municipal officials in that municipality to explain the reasons for that denial. It also adds a fiscal note to the bill.

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
