In addition, the bureau will collect dedicated 36 revenue in the amount of \$5,250 in fiscal year 1999-00 and \$15,750 in fiscal year 2000-01 from certification course fees 38 collected from all persons seeking certification. The

certification of newly employed on-premise alcohol servers will
 also generate additional General Fund revenues and dedicated revenues. These amounts will depend on the number of newly
 employed individuals and can not be determined at this time.

This bill may increase the number of cases filed in the Administrative Court. The additional workload and administrative
costs associated with the minimal number of new cases filed can be absorbed within the budgeted resources of the Judicial
Department. The collection of additional fines may also increase General Fund revenue by minor amounts.'
