

2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:**

4 **Sec. 1. PL 1997, c. 682, §3,** is amended to read:

6 **Sec. 3. Application.** Before July 1, ~~1999~~ 2004, only owners
8 who are members of road associations incorporated as of March 1,
10 ~~1998~~ 2003 may utilize the process set forth in this Act.

12 SUMMARY

14 Current law requires all members of a private road
16 association to pay for repairs made to the private road upon
18 agreement by the association. Prior to July 1, 1999, the law
only applies to those associations that were formed as of March
1, 1998.

This bill delays the application of the law by 5 years.
