6	C. Any changes in the <u>interior selling</u> location of <u>the</u> <u>premises</u> or renovations to the applicant's <u>licensed</u> premises;

12	This bill clarifies that the Bureau of Liquor Enforcement may consider changes to the selling location within a licensed
14	premises rather than changes in the physical location of the entire premises when it receives an application for renewal of a
16	liquor license.
