An Act to Increase the Amount of Income That a Resident of a Nursing or Residential Care Facility Who Receives Medicaid May Retain.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

Sec. 1. Rulemaking required. The Department of Human Services shall adopt rules amending the principles of reimbursement for nursing and residential care facilities to increase the amount of income that may be retained by the resident of a facility. The amount that may be retained by a nursing facility resident must be increased from \$40 to \$100. The amount that may be retained by a resident of a residential care facility must be increased from \$70 to \$120. Rules adopted pursuant to this provision are routine technical rules as defined by Title 5, chapter 375, subchapter II-A.

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SUMMARY

This bill requires the Department of Human Services to adopt rules increasing the amount of income that may be retained by residents of nursing and residential care facilities.
