COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 279, L.D. 387, Bill, "An Act to Exempt Persons 70 Years of Age and Older From Paying the Fee for Commercial Shellfish Licenses"

Amend the bill by inserting after section 1 the following:

'Sec. 2. Effective date. This Act takes effect May 1, 2000.'

Further amend the bill by inserting at the end before the summary the following:

**FISCAL NOTE**

<b>REVENUES</b>		
General Fund		(\$1,163)

The exemption of persons 70 years of age or older from paying the fee for commercial shellfish licenses will reduce General Fund revenue by a minor amount in fiscal year 1999-00 and by \$1,163 in fiscal year 2000-01.

The same exemption will result in insignificant reductions of dedicated revenue to the Department of Marine Resources from license fees.'
