2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:**

4 **Sec. 1. 12 MRSA §6601, sub-§5**, as amended by PL 1991, c. 591,
Pt. T, §4, is further amended to read:

6 **5. Fee.** The fee for a shellfish license is \$63, except
8 that for a person who has attained 70 years of age the fee is
waived.

10 **SUMMARY**

12 This bill exempts persons over 70 years of age from the fee
14 for a commercial shellfish license.
