**Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:**

**Sec. 1. 12 MRSA §7406, sub-§4,** as enacted by PL 1979, c. 420,  
4 §1, is amended to read:

6

**4. Hunting on Sunday.** A person is guilty of hunting on  
Sunday if he that person hunts wild animals or wild birds on  
8 Sunday. Notwithstanding the prohibition on Sunday hunting, a  
person may hunt on Sundays for small game, upland birds, wild  
10 duck and wild geese, during the open season for that game, on  
land under the jurisdiction of the Maine Land Use Regulation  
12 Commission.

This bill allows hunting on Sundays throughout land under  
18 the jurisdiction of the Maine Land Use Regulation Commission for  
small game, upland birds, wild ducks and wild geese.
