

4 **Sec. 1. 21-A MRSA §675 is enacted to read:**

6 **§675. Violations witnessed at polling place**

8 A registered voter witnessing a violation of this chapter at  
10 a polling place has standing to commence action in Superior Court  
12 requesting a declaration of violation or an injunction of relief.

14 **SUMMARY**

16 This bill gives a registered voter witnessing a violation at  
a polling place standing to seek an injunction of relief or  
declaration of violation in Superior Court.
