General Fund \$200,000

This bill includes a General Fund appropriation of \$200,000 in fiscal year 1999-00 to the Department of Education for the Interdepartmental Committee on Transition to assist public schools to comply with certain laws and regulations related to Maine's system of learning results. No funding for these activities is currently included in the Governor's proposed "current services" budget.'
