SENATE AMENDMENT " A " to H.P. 291, L.D. 399, Bill, "An Act to Ensure That All Students With Disabilities Exit School Ready for Employment or Postsecondary Education"

Amend the bill in section 1 in the 3rd line (page 1, line 6 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "1999-00" and inserting in its place the following:

'1999-00 2000-01'

Further amend the bill in section 1 in the 6th line (page 1, line 12 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "\$200,000" and inserting in its place the following:


'\$100,000 \$100,000'

FISCAL NOTE

The amendment decreases the General Fund cost of the bill by \$100,000 in fiscal year 1999-00 and increases the General Fund cost of the bill by \$100,000 in fiscal year 2000-01, resulting in no net fiscal impact for the 2000-2001 biennium.

SUMMARY

This amendment provides for General Fund appropriations of \$100,000 in each year of the biennium rather than a \$200,000 appropriation in fiscal year 1999-00.
