Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

Sec. 1. 26 MRSA §621, as amended by PL 1995, c. 340, §1, is further amended to read:

Certain employers; payment schedule. Every-cerperation, person-or-partnership-engaged-in-a-manufacturing,--meshanisal, mining,-quarrying,-mercantile,--restaurant,-hotel,--summer--samp, beauty-parler,-amusement,-telegraph-or-telephone-business;-in-any of-the-building-trades;-in-logging-or-lumbering-operation;-upon publis-werks-er-in-the-construction-or-repair--ef-reads,-bridges, sewers, -qas, -water-or-electric-light-works, -pipes-or-lines, -every incorporated - oxpress - company - or -water - company; - and - every - steam railread-company-er-corporation-shall-pay-weekly-each-employee engaged -- in -- its--business--the -- wages--earned--by--the -- employee--te within-8-days-of-the-date-of-that-paymenty-every-county-shall-se pay-every-employee-whe-is-engaged-in-its-business-the-wages-er salary - earned-by - that - employee, - unless - the - employee - requests - in writing-to-be-paid-in-a-different-manner. Municipalities shall pay their employees at least once every 2 weeks unless the employee agrees to be paid under a less frequent pay schedule. An employee who is absent from that employee's regular place of employment at a time fixed for payment must be paid on demand. An employer shall pay its employees at least once every 2 weeks.
