Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

2 **Sec. 1. 12 MRSA §7463-A, sub-§6**, as amended by PL 1997, c. 24,
4 Pt. I, §3, is further amended to read:

6 **6. Application procedure.** Eligible persons wishing to
8 apply for a permit must file a written application for a permit
10 on a form furnished by the commissioner. The application must be
12 accompanied by an application fee of \$5 for residents and \$10 for
14 nonresidents and aliens. The application fee may not be
refunded. A person may not file more than one application. Any
person who submits more than one application is disqualified from
the selection of permittees. ~~The application must be accompanied~~

18 (1)--Five-dollars-for-a-one-chance-application;

20 (2)---Ten--dollars--for--a--3-chance--application.---A
22 resident-must-possess-a-valid-big-game-hunting-license
to-be-eligible-to-purchase-a-3-chance-application;-and

24 (3)---Twenty--dollars--for--a--6-chance--application.---A
26 resident-must-possess-a-valid-big-game-hunting-license
to-be-eligible-to-purchase-a-6-chance-application;-or
