Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

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Sec. 1. 12 MRSA §6852, sub-§4, as amended by PL 1991, c. 591,
Pt. T, §15, is further amended to read:

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4. Fee. The fee for a retail seafood license is \$85, except
that the fee for a license issued after September 30th is \$42.50.

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SUMMARY

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This bill allows for a reduction in the retail seafood
license fee for a license issued after September 30th.
