

2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:**

4 **Sec. 1. 12 MRSA §7107-A, sub-§5, ¶F is enacted to read:**

6 F. Notwithstanding paragraph D and section 7458,  
8 subsections 1 and 2, a person who has taken a deer during  
10 the regular deer hunting season may hunt for and kill a 2nd  
12 deer with a muzzle-loading firearm during the muzzle-loading  
14 hunting season.

12 **SUMMARY**

14 This bill allows a person who has killed a deer during the  
16 regular deer hunting season to hunt and kill a 2nd deer with a  
muzzle-loading firearm during the muzzle-loading hunting season  
for deer.
