4 **Sec. 1. 29-A MRSA §2304, sub-§5** is enacted to read:

6 5. Seating limitation. The operator of a school bus may
8 not permit more than 2 students to sit on one seat if the
students are in 6th grade or above.

12 This bill limits to 2 the number of students who can sit on
one school bus seat if the students are in the 6th grade or above.
