COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 343, L.D. 459, Bill, "An  
Act to Ensure Equity in the Competitive Bidding Process for  
Construction Projects Supported by Public Funds"

Amend the bill in section 1 in that part designated "\$1310."  
by striking out all of the first indented paragraph and inserting  
in its place the following:

'The bidding process to award a contract for a construction  
project, whether privately or publicly owned, that is funded by  
state or municipal assistance may not exclude a worker, company  
or bidder because of the worker's, company's or bidder's union or  
nonunion status.'

This amendment clarifies that the bill does not require a  
competitive bidding process to be used for construction projects  
funded by state or municipal assistance. The bill only prohibits  
the exclusion of workers, companies and bidders based on their  
union or nonunion status.
