2	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows: Sec. 1. 28-A MRSA §1201, sub-§3-A, as amended by PL 1997, c. 373, §106, is repealed and the following enacted in its place:
6	3-A. Sale of liquor to another retailer. A person licensed
8	under this section, or an agent or employee of the person, may sell liquor to a retailer licensed to sell liquor for on-premises consumption and caterers licensed to sell liquor for consumption at the location sold.

16	This bill allows a retailer with a license to sell wine and malt liquor to be consumed off of the premises to sell wine and malt liquor to other entities with a license to sell liquor for

on-premise consumption.
