2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:**

4 **Sec. 1. 23 MRSA §1352 is enacted to read:**

6 **§1352. Construction signs**

8 When signs warning of construction ahead are located on
10 state highways, including controlled access highways, those signs
12 must be covered when no actual work is being performed. This
14 section does not include those instances in which the
16 construction work narrows the roadway.

14 **SUMMARY**

16 This bill requires that construction signs be covered on
18 state highways when no actual work is being performed, unless the
construction work narrows the roadway.
