30	Lands." The director may designate additional ecological reserves only in conjunction with the adoption of a management		
32	plan for a particular parcel of land and the process for adoption of that management plan must provide for public review and		
34	comment on the plan. When a proposed management plan includes designation of an ecological reserve, the director shall notify		
36	the joint standing committee of the Legislature having jurisdiction over matters pertaining to public lands of the
