
**APPROPRIATIONS/ALLOCATIONS**

General Fund    \$765                      \$510

The Board of Dental Examiners, affiliated with the Department of Professional and Financial Regulation, will require additional Other Special Revenue funds allocations of \$765 and \$510 in fiscal years 1999-00 and 2000-01, respectively, for the per diem and expenses related to increasing the membership of the board until January 1, 2001.
