COMMITTEE AMENDMENT " A " to S.P. 163, L.D. 483, Bill, "An Act to Include a Denturist on the Board of Dental Examiners"

Amend the bill by striking out everything after the enacting clause and before the summary and inserting in its place the following:

**Sec. 1. 32 MRSA §1071, first ¶**, as amended by PL 1993, c. 600, Pt. A, §56, is further amended to read:

The Until January 1, 2001, the Board of Dental Examiners, established by Title 5, section 12004-A, subsection 10, and in this chapter called the "board," consists of 7 8 members, appointed by the Governor as follows: five members of the dental profession, one dental hygienist, one denturist and one representative of the public. After January 1, 2001, the board consists of 7 members, appointed by the Governor as follows: 5 members of the dental profession, one dental hygienist and one representative of the public.

**Sec. 2. Allocation.** The following funds are allocated from Other Special Revenue funds to carry out the purposes of this Act.

32 **SUMMARY**

34 This amendment clarifies the bill by specifying that a  
36 dentist is added to the Board of Dental Examiners until January  
1, 2001. After January 1, 2001, the size of the board reverts  
38 back to 7 members. This amendment also adds an allocation  
section and a fiscal note to the bill.
