HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 361, L.D. 486, Bill, "An Act Regarding Fish Stocking"

Amend the amendment in section 1 in that part designated "§7013-A." in subsection 1 in the first and 2nd lines (page 1, lines 30 and 31 in amendment) by striking out the following: "Upon request by a person or persons or when" and inserting in its place the following: 'When'

Further amend the amendment in section 1 in that part designated "§7013-A." in subsection 1 in the 3rd line from the end (page 1, line 34 in amendment) by inserting after the following: "the" the following: 'Department of Inland Fisheries and Wildlife shall provide information regarding such a proposal to any person at that person's request. The'

FISCAL NOTE


The Department of Inland Fisheries and Wildlife will incur some minor additional costs to provide certain information in response to requests for that information. These costs can be absorbed within the department's existing budgeted resources.

SUMMARY

This amendment clarifies that when the Department of Inland Fisheries and Wildlife determines there is a need to consider changing the long-term management objectives regarding fish
