12	10. Fish Stocking; new species; unstocked water bodies. The adoption of rules pursuant to the Maine Administrative Procedure

16	A. Stocking a water body that has not been stocked for 5 or more years; or

20	B. Stocking a species of fish into a water body that has not previously been stocked into that water body.

28	This bill requires that the Bureau of Resource Management within the Department of Inland Fisheries and Wildlife adopt
