46	This amendment replaces the bill. It repeals the special statute of limitation that applies to land surveyors. The		
48	general 6-year statute of limitations will apply, without a discovery rule, consistent with the holding in Johnston v. Dow 8		
50	Coulombe, 686 A.2d 1064 (Me. 1996). It also adds a fiscal note to the bill.		
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
