	Emergency preamble. Whereas, Acts of the Legislature do not
2	become effective until 90 days after adjournment unless enacted
4	as emergencies; and
4	Whereas, Maine residents and health care providers have
6	encountered significant difficulties in the implementation of
v	Public Law 1997, chapter 793, on the confidentiality of health
8	care information; and
10	Whereas, the Legislature requires a period of time to
10	address these difficulties and to ensure that health care
12	information is provided appropriate confidential treatment; and
14	Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, these facts
	create an emergency within the meaning of the Constitution of
16	Maine and require the following legislation as immediately
	necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and
18	safety; now, therefore,
