	The department shall establish an alternative care option
8	for elderly and disabled adults who qualify for care in a nursing
	or residential care facility reimbursed through the Medicaid
10	program, The alternative care option must provide reimbursement
	for care in the home of the elderly or disabled person or in the
12	home of a guardian or family member of that person.
	Reimbursement must be provided at a rate that is equal to 75% of
14	the statewide average Medicaid reimbursement rate for the type of
16	facility for which the person qualifies.

18	SUMMARY
20	This bill provides a home-based care option for elderly or
	disabled persons who qualify for nursing facility care or
22	residential care reimbursed through the Medicaid program. The
	reimbursement rate is 75% of the statewide average Medicaid
24	reimbursement rate for the type of facility for which the person qualifies.
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
