Sec. 1. 12 MRSA §7463-A, sub-§2-A, ¶C, as amended by PL 1997,

C. In 1996 and 1997, no more than 1,500 permits; and

Sec. 2. 12 MRSA §7463-A, sub-§2-A, ¶D, as enacted by PL 1997,
c. 490, §2, is amended to read:

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D. In 1998 and ~~in each year thereafter~~ 1999, no more than
12 2,000 permits; and

Sec. 3. 12 MRSA §7463-A, sub-§2-A, ¶E is enacted to read:

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E. In 2000 and in each year thereafter, no more than 3,000
permits.
