24 Act to Decrease the Mahogany Quahog Tax from \$1.20 per Bushel to

28 Amend the bill by inserting at the end before the summary  
30 the following:

36 This bill will reduce budgeted General Fund revenue by  
38 \$32,000 in fiscal year 1999-00 and \$40,000 annually beginning in  
40 fiscal year 2000-01. Dedicated revenue of \$16,000 annually that  
42 currently accrues to the Toxin Monitoring Fund within the  
44 Department of Marine Resources will accrue, beginning in fiscal  
46 year 2000-01, to a new account within the department dedicated to  
48 the mahogany quahog industry. In addition, the new account will  
receive net additional dedicated revenue after the reduction of  
the tax of \$10,666 in fiscal year 1999-00 and \$2,667 annually  
beginning in fiscal year 2000-01. The total estimated revenue to  
the dedicated account will be \$10,666 in fiscal year 1999-00 and  
\$18,667 annually beginning in fiscal year 2000-01.'
