HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 179, L.D. 533, Bill, "An Act to Prohibit the State from Competing with Private Industry"


Amend the amendment in section 1 in that part designated "~~§55.~~" in subsection 1 in paragraph A in subparagraph (3) in the first and 2nd lines (page 2, lines 9 and 10 in amendment) by striking out the following: "appointed on a rotating basis" and inserting in its place the following: 'appointed by the Governor on a rotating basis in the following order'

Further amend the amendment in section 1 in that part designated "~~§55.~~" in subsection 2 by striking out all of paragraph C (page 2, lines 43 to 47 in amendment) and inserting in its place the following:

'C. Of the members initially appointed pursuant to subsection 1, paragraphs B, C and D, the 2 members representing the public must be appointed for terms of 3 years, the 2 members representing businesses with fewer than 100 employees must be appointed for terms of 2 years, the remaining member representing private enterprise and the member representing employees of State Government must be appointed for terms of one year; and'
