The Judicial Department may realize some minor savings from reductions of workload and administrative costs associated with the minimal number of cases that will no longer be filed in the court system. Reductions in the collection of fines may decrease General Fund revenue by minor amounts.'

SUMMARY

This amendment clarifies that nonresidents may transport home any lawfully harvested wild animals or wild birds, and that nonresidents may have game transported home by another individual or common carrier provided that that nonresident is properly licensed and has obtained a no-cost transportation permit. The amendment also adds a fiscal note to the bill.
