2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:**

4 **Sec. 1. 36 MRSA §6207, sub-§5** is enacted to read:

6 **5. Income adjustment for the elderly low cost drug**
8 **program. Beginning October 1, 1999, the State Tax Assessor shall**
10 **increase by 25% the income limitation for the elderly low cost**
12 **drug program under chapter 905.**

This bill increases by 25% the income eligibility
limitations for the elderly low cost drug program.
