An Act to Amend the Laws Governing the Purchase of Liquor by Commercial Entities.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows: 2 Sec. 1. 28-A MRSA §403, sub-§3, as enacted by PL 1987, c. 45, Pt. A, $\S4$, is amended to read: 4 б 3. Licensees may purchase liquor; price. Licensees authorized to sell liquor for off-premise consumption may purchase liquor for resale from the state discount liquor stores 8 at the same price they are permitted to purchase liquor for resale from any state store which that does not offer a retail 10 Licensees authorized to sell liquor for on-premise discount. 12 consumption may purchase liquor for resale from the state discount liquor stores at the discount price. 14 Sec. 2. 28-A MRSA §1403-A is enacted to read: 16 <u>§1403-A.</u> Return of wine and malt liquor products 18 1. Wholesale licensee shall accept returns. A wholesale 20 licensee shall accept the return of wine and malt liquor products sold to retail off-premise licensees and on-premise licensees if: 22 A. The product is returned to the wholesale licensee from 24 which it was purchased; 26 B. The product is undamaged and acceptable for resale, unless it was defective at the time of purchase; 28 C. A copy of the original purchase receipt is provided at 30 the time of the return; and 32 D. The return is made within 14 days of the original purchase. 34 2. Exchange value. The wholesale licensee shall provide a 36 refund for a returned product in an amount equal to the price of the product at the time of purchase. 38 40 SUMMARY 42 This bill would permit persons authorized to sell liquor for on-premise consumption to purchase liquor from a state discount 44 liquor store at the discount retail price and require wholesale licensees to accept returns of malt liquor and wine purchased by 46 retail and on-premise licensees.
