An Act to Change the Minimum Time for Issuing a Temporary Registered Gross Weight Increase from 2 Months to One Month.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

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	Sec. 1. 29-A MRSA §507, second and third ¶¶, as affected by PL
4	1995, c. 65, Pt. A, §153, amended by Pt. B, §3 and affected by Pt. C, §15, are further amended to read:
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	Temporary registered gross weight increases must be issued
8	for at least 2-months one month and may not exceed 8 months,
10	except-that-temperary-registered-gress-weight-increases-may-be
10	issued-for-one-menth-for-registered-farm-vehicles. A temporary
12	registered gross weight increase may not extend beyond the
12	expiration of the regular registration.
14	The fee for a temporary registered gross weight increase is
1.0	the difference between the annual fee for the original
16	registration and the annual fee for the desired temporary
18	registered gross weight multiplied by the percentage in the
10	following table:
20	One month (registered-farm-vehicle) 20%
22	2 months 30%
24	3 months 40%
26	4 months 50%
28	5 months 60%
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30	6 months 70%
32	7 months 75%
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34	8 months 80%
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	SUMMARY
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	This bill changes the minimum time for issuing temporary
40	gross weight licenses from 2 months to one month.
