Sec. 5. Applicability. This Act applies to all policies and 44 contracts executed, delivered, issued for delivery, continued or 46 renewed on or after the effective date of this Act. All policies and contracts are deemed to be renewed no later than the next yearly anniversary of the contract date. 48 50
