COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A " to S.P. 187, L.D. 580, Bill, "An Act to Clarify the Voting Rights of Persons Residing in Certain Sanitary Districts"

Amend the bill in section 1 in subsection 1 by striking out all of the blocked paragraph (page 1, lines 33 to 40 in L.D.) and inserting in its place the following:

'In the case of a sanitary district whose territory does not extend beyond the boundaries of a single municipality and whose territory encompasses less than the entire area of the municipality, all trustees must be residents of the municipality and a majority of the trustees must be residents within the district. A trustee who ceases to qualify for the office of trustee as a result of the application of this subsection shall vacate the office of trustee and the vacancy must be filled as provided in section 1105.'

**SUMMARY**

This amendment provides that for any sanitary district whose territory does not extend beyond the boundaries of a single municipality and whose territory encompasses less than the entire area of the municipality all trustees must be residents of the municipality and a majority of the trustees must be residents of the district.
