place the following:

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'Further amend the bill by striking out everything after the
enacting clause and before the summary and inserting in its place
the following:

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'Sec. 1. 1 MRSA §222 is enacted to read:

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§222. State soil

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The Caribou soil series is the official state soil.

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Sec. 2. 1 MRSA §223 is enacted to read:

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§223. No enhanced protection

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Designation as a state symbol under this subchapter does not
confer enhanced protection under the environmental laws or any
other applicable laws.'


