COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A " to S.P. 203, L.D. 592, Bill, "An Act to Establish the Chesuncook Soil Series as the Official State Soil"

Amend the bill by striking out the title and substituting the following:

'An Act to Establish the Chesuncook Soil Series as the Official State Soil and to Remove Enhanced Protection Status from State Symbols'

Further amend the bill by inserting after section 1 the following:

'Sec. 2. 1 MRSA §222 is enacted to read:

§222. No enhanced protection

Designation as a state symbol under this subchapter does not confer enhanced protection under the environmental laws or any other applicable laws.'

SUMMARY

This amendment adds a section to the bill to specify that designation as an official state symbol does not confer enhanced protection under environmental or other applicable laws.
