This amendment replaces the bill, adds an emergency preamble and emergency clause and allows a person to use fish scales as a crop nutrient supplement without a license as long as the type of scales and the process for extracting, handling and spreading the scales have received initial review and approval by the Department of Environmental Protection, that the farm using fish scales has developed and implemented a nutrient management plan and that the person supplying the fish scales provides the name of the person receiving the scales, the location where the scales will be used and the quantity of the fish scales shipped within 7 days of shipping the scales.
