SUMMARY

This amendment requires the Legislative Council to develop a plan that places all roll call votes of the Senate and the House of Representatives on the Internet within one hour of the roll call. The plan is required to be in place by the beginning of the Second Regular Session of the 119th Legislature. The plan is funded by \$5,000 each from the Rainy Day Fund and the legislative budget.
