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22	SUMMARY

This bill requires insurers, nonprofit hospital, medical or health care service organizations and health maintenance organizations to disclose to insured persons the profits of the company over the past 12 months or, in the case of a nonprofit organization, the salary of the organization's highest paid company official at the time the insureds are billed for an insurance policy or contract.
