_	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
2	Sec. 1. 20-A MRSA §1352, sub-§1, ¶C, as amended by PL 1989, c.
4	414, §5, is further amended to read:
б	C. The warrants and other notices for the referendum shall must be in the same manner as provided in Title 21-A, except
8	that the district board of directors shall hold a public hearing at least 10 days before the referendum vote. At
10	least 7 days before the public hearing, the board of directors shall give notice of the public hearing by having
12	a copy of the proposed referendum, together with the time and place of hearing, posted in the same manner required for
14	posting a warrant under this section.

18	SUMMARY
20	This bill requires school administrative districts to hold public hearings on all district referendum votes.
