Sec. 1. Evaluation of classification for milk haulers. Resolved: That
2 the Superintendent of Insurance shall evaluate whether milk
3 haulers should be classified separately from other long-distance
4 truckers under workers' compensation classification systems. If
5 the superintendent determines that a separate classification is
6 justified, the superintendent shall require a separate
7 classification for milk haulers when reviewing workers'
8 compensation classification systems pursuant to the Maine Revised
9 Statutes, Title 24-A, section 2382-B, subsection 1.

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14 This resolve requires the Superintendent of Insurance to
15 evaluate whether workers' compensation classification systems
16 should contain a separate classification for milk haulers.
