Sec. 1. Evaluation of classification for milk haulers. Resolved: That 2 the Superintendent of Insurance shall evaluate whether milk haulers should be classified separately from other long-distance 4 truckers under workers' compensation classification systems. If the superintendent determines that a separate classification is 6 justified, the superintendent shall require a classification for milk haulers when reviewing workers' compensation classification systems pursuant to the Maine Revised 8 Statues, Title 24-A, section 2382-B, subsection 1.
