Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

Sec. 1. 28-A MRSA §1355, sub-§3, ¶C, as amended by PL 1997, c. 373, §113, is further amended to read:

C. A holder of a farm winery license, upon application to and approval of the bureau and payment of the license fee fees, may obtain ~~a~~ license licenses for ~~one~~ up to 4 additional ~~location~~ locations other than the winery licensed under this subsection. The holder of the ~~license~~ licenses is not required to conduct any bottling or production of wine at the ~~2nd~~ additional licensed ~~location~~ locations but may conduct all activities permitted by this section at the winery.
