## Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

2 Sec. 1. 28-A MRSA §1355, sub-§3, ¶C, as amended by PL 1997, c. 373, §113, is further amended to read: 4 c. б A holder of a farm winery license, upon application to and approval of the bureau and payment of the license fee 8 fees, may obtain a--license licenses for one up to 4 additional legation locations other than the winery licensed 10 under this subsection. The holder of the license licenses is not required to conduct any bottling or production of wine at the 2nd additional licensed leeatien locations but may 12 conduct all activities permitted by this section at the 14 winery. 16 SUMMARY 18 This bill allows a holder of a farm winery license to apply 20 for licenses for up to 4 additional locations for the tasting of wine.
